Earth Day: Since Earth Day is on Thursday, April 22 we will take time next week to celebrate the amazing planet that God has blessed us with and told us to care for. We'll also examine the problem with the growing amount of pollution and what we can do about it!

It means “to watch and protect.” The other important word in this verse is “work” and is from the Hebrew word “`abad” meaning “to serve”. So Genesis 2:15 could be more accurately read as: “The Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to serve it, to guard it, and protect it.”
